Neighborhood Cleanup December 3

NOTE: Leaf Collection is scheduled for Midtown every Thursday Nov 21 through Dec 16. Large piles of leaves should be swept into the street, next to the curb. City sweeper or vacuum trucks will collect the leaves from the street. When possible, street cleaning will post signage the day before for large volume leaf pick-up.
